Soiled or worn items cannot be entered, and will not be judged. No items will be sold in the Floral Hall Departments.

*New this year:* **Fleece & Fiber** Competition (see Section 9) Sheep or other natural animal fiber accepted. Include both breed and class information on entry form. All entries must be thoroughly skirted and in a clean plastic or cloth bag. Fleeces will not be sold at the fair, but exhibitors may include contact information on their entry. Questions?
