Judges consider workmanship, and a creative approach to specific craft. Contestants are encouraged to inspect items for spots, stains and markings. Soiled or worn items cannot be entered, and will not be judged. No items will be sold in the Floral Hall Departments.

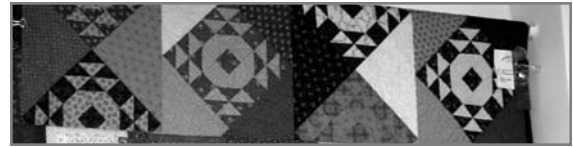
