

## DEPARTMENT 50

Please see the Health Standards form for rules, requirements and recommendations to register and show at our fair and you must follow the protocol for presenting paperwork upon arrival. Please be sure to print a copy of the Health Standards form for your reference.

ALL HORSES MUST BE IN SOLID SHOW CONDITION WITH GOOD WEIGHT, BODY TONE, SOUND FEET AND TEMPERMENT. THEY MUST BE SAFE IN THEIR STALLS. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY ANY HORSE UNFIT OR UNSAFE.

All fees and entries are due between August 1-15, however they are accepted in the order in which they are received and stalls may be full prior to August 15.

• Equines will not be released before 6:00 PM on Sunday. Please do not load or leave before this time. Failure to comply with this rule may result in loss of premiums.

**Only one horse per exhibitor will be strictly enforced.** Each horse can be used by different exhibitors, each with their own number and fee where required. No horse under 3 yrs. old can be ridden at the fair. A green horse must be at least 3 yrs. od.

### Fees:

- No fee for junior exhibitors.
  - Entry fee for those 18 and older is \$15.00.
  - Exhibitors must wear wrist band on wrist all 4 days
  - Stall fees are \$20.00 (includes 2 bags of shavings). Checks payable to the Union Agricultural Society.
  - Camping fees and rules are on entry form.
- ALL REGISTERED BREEDS must show proof of registration to the Superintendents.  
See Dept. 190 Class 3 Rare Breed Horse.

### SAFETY!

- ASTM certified/SEI approved helmets are required for all exhibitors under age 18 **whenever** mounted.
- Halter, lead rope and emergency stall cards must be displayed at **EVERY** stall door.
- Stall guards must be used in **every stall** (exception for Minis & small ponies).
- There will be scheduled turnout in the ring.
- Always walk your horses in the horse area.
- Areas in front of stalls need to be kept neat and clear of vehicles and animals.
- All animals are to be in stalls by 8pm, absolutely no riding after 7pm.
- Problem/unsafe animals will be dismissed at the discretion of the Superintendent.

### Class divisions will be by rider's age, as of January 1st of the current year:

- No child under 3 yrs may show in any class except Stick Horse.

**Lead Line:** 3-7 yrs, rider must have a handler

**Pony:** 5-8 yrs, ring master can assist

**Beginner:** 8-13 yrs and have not shown in a canter/lope class.

**Junior:** 9-13 yrs will show at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope.

**Senior:** 14-18 yrs will show at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope.

**Adult:** 19 yrs and older will show at a walk, trot/jog, canter/lope.

**Open Walk Trot:** 14yrs and older will show at a walk, trot/jog and cannot enter any class requiring a canter/lope

**NOVICE HORSE: RIDERS 18 OR OLDER ONLY! HORSE MUST BE 3 OR OLDER HORSES MAY ENTER NOVICE CLASSES ONLY!**

- Small classes may be combined and large classes may be divided at the discretion of the Judge.

SECTION 1. Judy Reed Memorial Pony Parade: class for children to creatively show off the theme of the fair with their pony (exhibitors can have a handler).

SECTION 2. Fitting and Showing

Judged on appearance of the animal (condition, grooming, trimming, braiding, and tack), appearance of the exhibitor, and showing in the ring (leading, posing, poise, alertness and attitude).
