Under Vermont Law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities that are obvious and necessary, pursuant to 12 V.S.A. 1039, I agree to hold harmless any organization affiliated with this show, which includes, but is not limited to, Union Agricultural Society and/or Tunbridge Worlds Fair, for damages to horses/ponies, riders, spectators, and any vehicle or property at this show.
