Make sure to read and review the Health Standards Form for the swine department and save or print it for your reference.

NOTE: Provide contact number on entry form so we can reach you about space or any new health regulations and procedures.

—Entries will be accepted in the order they are received until pens are filled.

—Sorting panels are required to show your animal in all classes. Exhibitors must provide their own. These can be homemade. The only requirement is that animals are handled appropriately. The Fair reserves the right to excuse exhibitors from the ring when this is not the case. Any such situation will result in a review by the Fair's board determining if the exhibitor will also be excused from the fairgrounds with no prizes awarded.

—Animals causing safety concerns will be excused from the ring and or fairgrounds with no prizes awarded. It is recommended you verify that your animals respond to a sorting panel prior to bringing them to the fair.

—The Fair reserves the right to combine or split any classes to accommodate the number of entries and promote healthy competition. Registration papers may be requested to qualify for Registered classes.

—To help ensure the health and welfare of all animals you must adhere to the health regulations listed on the Health Standards Form. Animals in question will have to be cleared by a veterinarian.

—Upon arrival see superintendent for pen assignment and to have your animals reviewed. Any health concerns will be determined by a veterinarian at the owner's expense. For animals entered in registered classes, a copy of the registration certificate needs to be available. Animals for which a registration certificate cannot be produced will be required to show in the commercial/crossbred classes. Please bring an extra copy of the registration certificate to leave with the superintendent.

—Agility competition is a timed event where each exhibitor takes the animal through an obstacle course. Juniors and adults have three events to qualify for the finals on Sunday afternoon.

—Painted Pig is for Junior exhibitors only. In this class exhibitors decorate their pig and themselves.

—Classes with only one entry may not be shown in the ring.
