All exhibits will be inspected upon arrival by a veterinarian, superintendent or assistant superintendent before entering the Children's Barnyard.

Out of state exhibitors are required to obtain an import permit from the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets, Montpelier, VT. Call or write for them early!
