

Tunbridge World's Fair
The Fair Through My Eyes Youth Contest 2026
Rules and Expectations

Youth respond to the prompt: "What did I learn at the Tunbridge World's Fair?"

Deadline: Entries must be received by the Tunbridge Fair office by October 15, 2026.

Entries must be labeled and include parent permission entry form to be considered. Entries may be submitted in one of the following forms:

- Narrative essay (limit to 300 words or less)
- Poetry
- Photograph and Caption
- Visual Art (drawing, painting, printmaking, mixed media, or sculpture) Digital images of original work will be accepted; work will not be returned.

There will be five age categories, with one entry selected in each age category to receive an award of \$100. All ages should be as of September 1, 2026.

- 5-7 years old
- 8-10 years old
- 11-13 years old
- 14-18 years old
- Judges' Choice Award - open to all youth, age 18 and under

Entries may be:

The contest is open to students attending public or private school, as well as home schooled students.

Contest submissions must be original work. Entries will be reviewed for AI influence.

A committee of judges will review all applications and select the winners. Winners will be contacted by November 6, 2026.

Entries submitted (including photographs of art or excerpts from essays or poems) may be displayed in Tunbridge World's Fair promotional materials, social media, or web site, and many will be highlighted at the fair's annual meeting in December.
